Women and Children's Tower:

Our current funding priority is the new Women and Children's Tower, which represents an important expansion of Peyton Manning Children's Hospital. This new world-class facility will be the home to the highest levels of specialty care provided by multidisciplinary medical teams all in a single location. This will enhance efficiency

and quality of care, and also ensure that moms and babies are able to stay together when receiving care.

Healing Arts Therapies: The Healing Arts Therapies Program includes art, music, and dance/movement therapies, and helps alleviate feelings of helplessness and lack of control that are often associated with hospitalization. Participation provides children with a way to become more actively engaged in their medical treatment and express their fears and feelings in creative, healthy, and healing ways.

Child Life Services: Child Life Services helps patients by providing techniques for pain management and relaxation to minimize fears and improve coping skills. Philanthropic funding for Child Life Services is utilized to acquire toys and medical dolls and assist with demonstrations and other programmatic needs.



School Program: When in the hospital, kids may miss days or weeks of school at a time. Peyton Manning Children's Hospital employs a full-time, on-site teacher to help all patients avoid falling behind in school during their hospitalizations to the greatest extent possible so these patients can successfully be re-acclimated to their home schools with minimal difficulty.

Pediatric Oncology Research: The Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Diseases at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital participates in pediatric cancer clinical trials and research through the Children's Oncology Group (COG), as well as industry funded trials. Philanthropic funding facilitates this participation by providing pediatric cancer patients with access to new testing, treatments and medications that are not covered by insurance. This ensures that every patient has equal opportunity to benefit from access to promising advances in pediatric cancer care. Every new oncology patient is evaluated for open clinical trials to determine the best course of treatment.



Ascension St. Vincent House:

The Ascension St. Vincent House offers overnight accommodations for families who live more than 60 miles from Ascension St. Vincent, and includes 20 guest rooms, meditation spaces, dining areas, laundry facilities, playground space and more. Continued funds are

needed for programs and meals for families, and ongoing maintenance and updates.

- Use of Ascension St. Vincent names, logos or trademarks on brochures, promotional items, handouts and giveaways must be reviewed and approved in advance by Ascension St. Vincent.
- Fundraising events must comply with all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations.
- Funds raised from the event should be provided to the Ascension St. Vincent Foundation within 30 days of the event date.
- All parties planning fundraising events agree that they are independent from Ascension St. Vincent.

- Ascension St. Vincent Foundation sales tax exempt number
- Insurance or liability coverage
- Mailing list of donors, prospects and Ascension

- Guaranteed publicity (newspaper, radio, television, etc.)
- Cash or in-kind donations (including event sponsors)

School Fundraising Ideas

Interested in hosting a FUNdraiser for Peyton Manning Children's Hospital at Ascension St. Vincent at your school? Below are a few ideas to get you started. Feel free to make them your own, and brainstorm other ideas, too!

Car Wash

Football Frenzy
