The inaugural year of Called to Care has been marked by remarkable achievements, community involvement, and contributions to Peyton Manning Children's Hospital. Called to Care is a group of compassionate women who share a calling to help, heal, and care.



Together, this special group **serves** patients, **supports** crucial programs, and **raises awareness** at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital. In 2024, 73 members were called to join and awarded \$125,000 in Impact Grants, furthering the organization's mission to support Peyton Manning Children's Hospital.



First year in review

Fundraising events have played a crucial role in supporting Called to Care's mission. One standout event was the Stags' Leap Wine Dinner hosted at Prime 47 Carmel in February, which attracted more than 100 attendees. The event raised over \$40,000 supporting Peyton Manning Children's Hospital.

Building on this success, additional events are planned for 2025, promising even more opportunities to engage the community and raise funds for these vital causes.

2024 Impact Grants

\$100,000 Impact Grant

The first grant was \$100,000 awarded to support the School Program at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital. This program offers instruction and tutoring in a structured classroom setting for patients who must miss extended periods of school. It also provides a liaison role between the hospital and the patient's home school to create individualized care plans.

This Impact Grant will fund a PRN position for up to 10 hours per week for a minimum of 5 years to support the program's growth due to increased caseloads and patient volumes over the last 10 years.

\$25,000 Impact Grant

The second grant, a \$25,000 Impact Grant, was awarded to Nursing Scholarships. These scholarships are available to full-time and part-time associates who have been employed for at least one year at an eligible Ascension St. Vincent facility and are pursuing an associate's, bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree at an accredited school.

The Called to Care Nursing Scholarship will support one recipient per year with a \$5,000 award for the next 5 years, specifically for nurses specializing in pediatrics and/or maternal health.
