\$100,000 Impact Grant

Intracranial Monitors for Pediatric Neurosurgery

This \$100,000 Impact Grant will purchase three new Pressio systems, which is a safer intracranial pressure (ICP) monitoring system with wider applicability for management of pediatric patients with traumatic brain injury at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital.

\$50,000 Impact Grant

Neptune Suction Device for Women and Infants Hospital Operating Room

This \$50,000 Impact Grant will equip the operating rooms at the Women and Infants Hospital at Ascension St. Vincent with a Neptune 3 Closed Fluid Waste Management System and one Smart Docking Station that will significantly enhance patient and staff safety, procedural efficiency, and hemorrhage response and better protect caregivers, improve real-time decision-making, and optimize outcomes for mothers experiencing life-threatening blood loss.

\$100,000 Impact Grant

Statewide Pregnancy and Newborn Education App

This \$100,000 Impact Grant will provide unlimited access to the app for all obstetrician patients across all seven delivering hospitals for three years, providing them with digital, evidence based and accessible education at their fingertips and helping Ascension St. Vincent take another step towards decreasing the maternal and infant mortality rate in Indiana.

\$50,000 Impact Grant

Crisis Resource Kits for the Child Abuse Team

This \$50,000 Impact Grant will support crisis resource kits, which will allow the Child Abuse team at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital to provide personalized kits in reusable bags for all levels of ages, including basic essential items such as diapers, clothing, small gifts, and toys that are crucial to caring for each child.
