Nursing Scholarships

Annually, the Nancy Pitcock Nursing Scholarship provides funds for associates wishing to pursue a degree in nursing at Ivy Tech Anderson or Anderson University. Scholarships are available to full and part-time associates who:

- Completed at least one year of consecutive employment at Ascension St. Vincent Anderson Hospital
- Apply for or are currently pursuing an associate's or bachelor's degree in nursing at Ivy Tech Community College or Anderson University

Associate Assistance Program

Peyton Manning Children's - St. John's Children's Clinic

For 48 years, the Children's Clinic at Ascension St. Vincent Anderson has been the answer for families who might otherwise be deciding between food on the table or immunizations for their children.

The Foundation continues to provide annual operational support to the clinic, which sees 2,200 children a year and performs approximately 3,500 medical treatments. The clinic is a medical home to Madison County children ages birth to 18 who are uninsured and whose families have limited or no financial resources. Visit
